## LIQUIDATOR'S MOTION CONCERNING LIQUIDATOR'S REPORTS

NOW COMES Roger A. Sevigny, Commissioner of Insurance for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home") and U.S. International Reinsurance Company ("USI Re") (collectively, the "Companies"), and moves that the Court enter an order providing that the Liquidator is to file reports with the Court quarterly instead of monthly. As reasons therefor, the Liquidator states as follows:

- 1. Since the entry of the Orders of Liquidation for the Companies in June, 2003, the Liquidator has submitted fourteen monthly reports to the Court pursuant to RSA 402-C:25. That section provides that the Liquidator "shall report to the court monthly, or at other intervals specified by the court, on the progress of the liquidation in whatever detail the court orders." RSA 402-C:25, first unnumbered paragraph.
- 2. As discussed at the hearing on November 12, 2004, the liquidation of the Companies has progressed to a stage where monthly written reports are not necessary to report on significant developments in the liquidation. The Liquidator submits that

quarterly written reports would now be sufficient. The Liquidator will continue to file motions as has been done in the past. The Liquidator would file written reports on a quarterly basis.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator respectfully requests that this Court:

- A. Grant this Motion to provide for quarterly filing of Liquidator's Reports;
- B. Enter an Order in the form submitted herewith approving such Motion; and
- C. Grant such other and further relief as justice may require.
