AND CONTINENTAL INSURANCE COMPANY**


On consideration of the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Commissioner of Insurance for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of the The Home Insurance Company ("Home") for an order approving four (4) Reinsurance Commutation Agreements, Settlements and Releases (the "Agreements") between Home and certain London market reinsurers and reinsurance pools (the "Reinsurers"), and the supporting confidential affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Agreements are reasonable, prudent and in full accordance with law;
2. The Agreements are in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
3. The Agreement is entered into in good faith; and
4. The Liquidator's Motion for Approval of Reinsurance Commutation Agreements with St. Paul UK Group and Continental Insurance Company is GRANTED, and the Agreements are APPROVED.
