**LIQUIDATOR'S RESPONSE TO CIC'S SURREPLY  
ON KWELM COMPANIES' PROOFS OF CLAIM**

The Liquidator hereby responds to two factual issues first raised in CIC's surreply in opposition to the Liquidator's report on the KWELM Companies' proofs of claim.

1. In the surreply, CIC asserts that KWELM continues to pursue claims against Home and that "since February 7, 2006 alone . . . KWELM has submitted hundreds of thousands of dollars in claims against Home to AISUK." CIC Surreply ¶ 2, Ex. 1. The Affidavit of Nick Tyndall submitted by CIC provides no supporting details. However, as described in the Affidavit of Jonathan Rosen attached as Exhibit 1 hereto, the claim submissions are "pipeline" claims that have been working their way from KWELM to Home through brokers for long periods of time. Rosen Aff. ¶¶ 2-4. The claim submissions recommended to Home by Mr. Tyndall during 2006 are all attached to the Rosen Affidavit, and they all bear broker issuance dates between October 1997 and October 2005. They do not represent action by KWELM to submit claims after February 7, 2006. *Id.* ¶ 4, Ex. A.<sup>1</sup>

2. CIC also asserts that a letter from Gareth Hughes dated April 12, 2006 was sent "so that KWELM may continue to have those self-same claims processed and adjudicated." CIC Surreply ¶ 3, Ex. 2. CIC mischaracterizes the letter. As evident from the letter itself and as

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<sup>1</sup> Even putting the Scheme Adjudicator's decision aside, CIC's assertion in footnote 3 of the Surreply that approximately \$700,000 in paid amounts are disputed is incorrect. There are approximately \$433,000 in pipeline claims agreed to by AISUK since June 2005 that have not been submitted for approval by the Liquidator in light of the overall resolution of the KWELM-Home relationship under the Scheme. Rosen Aff. ¶ 6.


described in the Rosen Affidavit, it concerns a standstill agreement entered by KWELM Management Services Limited (“KMS”) acting for the companies on the Weavers and Driver stamps, which included many companies other than the five KWELM Companies. (A listing of the companies is attached to the standstill agreement.) Rosen Aff. ¶ 5. Indeed, CIC admits that the Joint Provisional Liquidator’s letter seeks “confirmation that a 1996 Standstill Agreement between the H.S. Weavers and C.R. Driver Stamp Companies and Home applies to AFIA claims.” CIC Surreply ¶ 3 (emphasis added). The letter does not concern KWELM company claims but the Weavers stamp companies generally, as shown by the list of claims attached to the letter. The letter was prompted by concerns raised by one stamp company and AFIA Cedent, St. Paul, over CIC’s refusal to apply the standstill agreement to St. Paul’s claims. Rosen Aff. ¶ 5, Ex. B. The letter does not suggest that KWELM continues to prosecute claims.



**AFFIDAVIT OF JONATHAN ROSEN**

I, Jonathan Rosen, depose and say:

1. I am the Chief Operating Officer of The Home Insurance Company In Liquidation, a position I have held since shortly after the liquidation commenced. Prior to that, I was Executive Vice President and Reinsurance Counsel of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”) and Executive Vice President of Risk Enterprise Management Limited, a third party administrator that, amongst other things, administered the business of Home. The facts and information set forth below are either within my own knowledge, in which case I confirm that they are true, or are based on information provided to me by others, in which case they are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

2. The KWELM Companies (in Scheme of Arrangement since 1993) have historically submitted claims to Home through London market brokers, such as ReSolutions International Ltd. (“ReSolutions”) and Axiom, with respect to Home’s AFIA-related KWELM inwards business. KWELM advised the brokers of the claims, and the brokers prepared and issued what are known in the London market as CP 13 claim forms, which the brokers presented to ACE INA Services U.K. Limited (“AISUK”) for adjustment on Home’s behalf. AISUK acted on the claims without any Home involvement prior to Home’s liquidation and made or makes recommendations thereon to the Liquidator after Home’s liquidation. Since the claims are transmitted through the brokers, there is a lag – sometimes quite a significant lag – between the

time of KWELM's claim notifications to the brokers and the brokers' actual claims presentation to AISUK (on behalf of Home). Claims that are in process between a reinsured (such as KWELM) and a reinsurer (such as Home) are colloquially referred to as "pipeline" claims.

3. Copies of all of the recommendations made by AISUK to the Liquidator (through the Joint Provisional Liquidators) since January 1, 2006 are attached as Exhibit A. They consist of four letters from Mr. Tyndall at AISUK (dated March 27, April 3, and two April 10, 2006) each enclosing the brokers' CP 13 claim forms with AISUK's recommendations or (as to certain of the forms enclosed with the second April 10, 2006 letter) questions noted.

4. The dates that the broker issued the CP 13 claim forms are set forth on the forms. The forms enclosed with Mr. Tyndall's letters bear dates between October 1997 and October 2005. These claims are "pipeline" claims, and they do not represent action by KWELM to submit claims after February 7, 2006, the date of the Scheme Adjudicator's adjudication that established the overall net debtor liability of each of the KWELM companies to Home.

5. The Joint Provisional Liquidator's letter dated April 12, 2006 and attached as Exhibit 2 to the CIC Surreply concerns a standstill agreement (attached as an exhibit to the letter) that covers claims by the so-called Weavers and Driver stamp companies (companies whose participation in a contract was noted by affixing a "stamp" listing the companies). The agreement was entered by KWELM Management Services Limited ("KMS") acting for the companies on the Weavers and Driver stamps, which included many companies other than the five KWELM companies. (A listing of the companies is attached to the standstill agreement.) The Joint Provisional Liquidator's letter refers to KMS as "KWELM" (see the re line), but it does not concern KWELM company claims but the Weavers stamp companies generally (see the list of claims attached to the letter). As is shown by the email from one of the Joint Provisional

Liquidator's staff attached as Exhibit B, the letter was prompted by concerns raised by one stamp company and AFIA Cedent, St. Paul, over CIC's refusal to apply the standstill agreement to St. Paul's claims.

6. In his adjudication, the Scheme Adjudicator certified that of the \$3,910,842 that he determined was due by Home to the KWELM companies, \$2,490,765 related to unsettled paid losses. Of that amount, the Liquidator had previously recommended, and this Court approved, \$1,668,427 of determined KWELM company claims that had been agreed by AISUK. AISUK has also agreed \$433,539 of unsettled "pipeline" paid loss claims due by Home to the KWELM companies, encompassed in the Scheme Adjudicator's certification, which have not been submitted by the Liquidator to the Court in light of the Liquidator's presently pending report. As such, CIC is incorrect in its assertion in footnote 3 of its Surreply that "[t]he remaining \$2.2 million is comprised of (i) approximately \$700,000 in disputed 'unpaid paid' which CIC maintains are not recoverable from Home."


