LIQUIDATOR'S RESPONSE TO ACE MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Roger A. Sevigny, Commissioner of Insurance for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of the Home Insurance Company ("Home"), hereby responds to the motion of Century Indemnity Company, ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company, Pacific Employers Insurance Company, and ACE American Reinsurance Company (collectively, "ACE") to extend for one week the time for them to object to the Liquidator's motion for approval of a settlement agreement between the Liquidator and Home's policyholders Cleaver-Brooks, Inc. and The Coca-Cola Company.

1. The Liquidator does not object to ACE's requested one week (to April 16, 2007) extension of time for them to object to the proposed settlement agreement.
2. The Liquidator reserves all rights with respect to any objection ACE may ultimately file to the Liquidator's motion.




