LIQUIDATOR'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME TO RESPOND  
TO CIC's MOTION TO LIFT STAY AND TO COMPEL ARBITRATION

Roger A. Sevigny, Commissioner of Insurance for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home"), hereby moves to enlarge the time for the Liquidator to respond to the Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration filed by Century Indemnity Company ("CIC") to and including May 5, 2008. As reasons therefore, the Liquidator states:

1. On April 1, 2008, CIC filed and served its Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration, together with a Memorandum of Law of Century Indemnity Company Supporting Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration and a compendium of Non-New Hampshire Cases and Statutes Cited in Memorandum of Law of Century Indemnity Company Supporting Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration.

2. CIC's motion and its 34-page memorandum present numerous and potentially complex issues regarding both the stay in the liquidation order and the newly-proposed arbitration. To properly respond to CIC's motion, the Liquidator will need additional time. The Liquidator believes that an extension of approximately three weeks is necessary and will provide adequate time.

3. The Liquidator accordingly requests that the Court enlarge the time for the Liquidator to respond to CIC's motion to and including May 5, 2008.
