**CENTURY INDEMNITY COMPANY'S**  
**ASSENTED-TO MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE A REPLY**  
**TO THE LIQUIDATOR'S OBJECTION**

Century Indemnity Company ("CIC") hereby moves for leave to file a reply to the Liquidator's Objection and Memorandum in Opposition to CIC's Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration (the "Liquidator's Objection") before the Court rules on CIC's Motion to Lift Stay and to Compel Arbitration (CIC's Motion), specifically, by May 30, 2008. As reasons therefore, CIC states:

1. On May 5, 2008, the Liquidator's Objection was filed and served on CIC. It consisted of a 39-page Memorandum of Law and nearly 250 pages of exhibits. Like CIC's Motion, the Liquidator's Objection presents complex issues of law. Because of the significance of the issues raised in connection with CIC's Motion, CIC requests leave to file a reply to the Liquidator's Objection before the Court rules. To have adequate time to properly address these issues, CIC further requests that it be permitted to file its reply on May 30, 2008.

2. Counsel for CIC has conferred with counsel for the Liquidator and is authorized to represent that the Liquidator assents to the requested relief.

WHEREFORE, CIC requests that the Court grant this motion and permit CIC to file a reply to the Liquidator's Objection on May 30, 2008.
