**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT  
WITH SAUGET ESTATE AND OTHERS**

On consideration of the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”), for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release (“Settlement Agreement”) between The United States of America on behalf of U.S. EPA, the estate of Paul C. Sauget on behalf of itself and Sauget and Company (“the Estate”), Solutia Inc., Parmicia Corporation, Cerro Flow Products, Inc., and Union Electric Company (hereinafter collectively referred to as “Claimants”), and the Liquidator, and the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Sauget Estate and Others is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the Claimants’ proofs of claim is approved, and the Claimants’ claims are allowed as a Class II claim in the aggregate amount of \$4,125,000. All distributions shall be made to the Executor of the Estate.
