
ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
WITH NEENAH-MENASHA SEWERAGE COMMISSION

On consideration of (a) the motion of Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company, for an order approving a Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release ("Settlement Agreement") between Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission and the Liquidator, and (b) the supporting Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Settlement Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home;
2. The Liquidator's Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission is granted, and the Settlement Agreement is approved; and
3. The Liquidator's recommendation concerning the allowance of the proofs of claim filed by Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission is approved and Neenah-Menasha Sewerage Commission's claim is allowed as an unexcused late-filed Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45, RSA 402-C:44, and RSA 402-C:37 in the aggregate amount of \$525,000.
