**ORDER APPROVING REINSURANCE COMMUTATION
AGREEMENT WITH USF&G**

On consideration of the motion of John R. Elias, Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator (“Liquidator”) of The Home Insurance Company (“Home”), for an order approving the Reinsurance Commutation, Settlement and Release Agreement (the “Agreement”) between the Liquidator and United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company (“USF&G”), and the supporting confidential affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, Special Deputy Liquidator, it is hereby found and ORDERED as follows:

1. The Agreement is reasonable, prudent, and in the best interests of the liquidation of Home; and
2. The Liquidator’s Motion for Approval of the Reinsurance Commutation Agreement with USF&G is GRANTED, and the Agreement is APPROVED.
3. The Liquidator’s recommendation concerning the allowance of the proofs of claim filed by USF&G is approved and USF&G’s claims are allowed as a Class V claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45 and RSA 402-C:44 in the net aggregate amount of \$1,320,574 (not including Future Claims as defined in the Agreement).
