On July 27, 1976, a door fell
out of a closet door, which
then fell on me. It fractured
and crushed my foot. I was
26 years old at the time.

After many operations
my left great toe was
removed. My life was
forever changed. At 26, I
had to learn how to walk
again, it took many years
along with the everyday PAIN.

Over the last few years
it seems I have been
denied for everything, from
medicine, shoes/walk in tub
ramp/ing board for car, to
doctor bills. My foot doctor

has tried to help me
with my pain which
has gotten worse over the
years. Dr. Palmer had prescribed
a pain patch it was not
covered by insurance, cost
was \$260-. Office calls
all related to left foot
are now up to \$150⁰⁰-. The
Michigan Property & Casualty
denied all requests & they
stated not related to injury?
Many times I have
requested a call from
a representative, to discuss
and defend the denials,
but to no avail.

Far over a year after
the accident I had to
seek help from a physicalist
it helped some with
the loss of my toe but
I am still hindered
daily that I can no

longer wear stylish shoes
the ability to read, the
length of time I am
able to walk without
a walker.

Home insurance tried on
December 15, 1982 to pay
me a lump sum and
sign off any liabilities
of said no. My attorney
told me I had coverage
for life in regards
for all care on left foot.

I feel it should be
compensated for all the
years of pain and anguish
that I had to endure, plus
all bills paid by me
attorney or court fees.
In the future any
after calls, possible
operations, shoes, medicine
and because my balance

is getting worse and am going
to do use a aid walker
now at times. Cost could
be \$75,000 or higher.
