The Liquidator's recommendation concerning the allowance of the proof of claim filed by Claimant is approved and Claimant's claim is allowed as a Class II claim in accordance with RSA 402-C:45 and RSA 402-C:44 in the total amount of \$353,602.53 (consisting of the First Allowed Amount of \$333,602.53 and the Second Allowed Amount of \$20,000).
