LIQUIDATOR'S RESPONSE TO GOODRICH CORPORATION'S MOTION TO PARTICIPATE IN DISPUTED CLAIM PROCEEDING

John R. Elias, Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home"), hereby responds to the motion to participate filed by Goodrich Corporation ("Goodrich") in this disputed claim proceeding regarding the claim of PolyOne Corporation ("PolyOne").

- 1. The Liquidator does not object to Goodrich's motion to participate in this disputed claim proceeding insofar as Goodyear seeks to participate on the issues identified in its motion: the choice of the applicable law and the allocation methodology to be applied to PolyOne's and Goodrich's claims regarding the Calvert City, Kentucky site. See Goodrich's motion at 2.
- The Liquidator does not agree that Goodrich has an interest in all issues that may be raised in this disputed proceeding regarding PolyOne's claim. Since Goodrich has not identified issues beyond the choice of applicable law and allocation methodology, the Liquidator reserves the right to object to Goodrich's participation on other issues as appropriate.1

¹ The Liquidator notes that he does not agree with the characterizations of litigation in Ohio set forth on page 2 of Goodrich's motion. The Liquidator further notes that both PolyOne and Goodyear have misidentified the policies under which PolyOne asserts its claims. PolyOne's claim and the Liquidator's notice of determination concern Home policies HEC4356627 and HEC4356857 issued to B. F. Goodrich Company.
