LIQUIDATOR'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO CONTINUE ORAL ARGUMENT

Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home"), hereby requests that the Referee continue the oral argument scheduled for July 20, 2009. As reasons therefor, the Liquidator states:


1. Telephonic oral argument in this matter has been scheduled for July 20, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.
2. Counsel for the Liquidator is also involved in a recently filed case with an expedited briefing and hearing schedule. Tuttle v. New Hampshire Medical Malpractice Joint Underwriting Association, et al., No. 09-E-148 (Belknap County Superior Court). The Court (McGuire, J.) has directed that dispositive motions in the case be filed July 10, with replies to be filed July 17, 2009. A final hearing has been scheduled for July 20, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.
3. Due to this conflict, the Liquidator requests that the telephonic oral argument in this matter be rescheduled to a date convenient to the Referee and the parties.

4. Counsel for the Liquidator has consulted with counsel for the Holsons, and the Holsons assent to this motion. Counsel will confer and propose potential dates for argument to the Liquidation Clerk.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator requests that the Referee continue the oral argument scheduled for July 20, 2009 until a future date.


