**REFEREE'S RULING ON CENTURY INDEMNITY COMPANY'S
REQUEST FOR AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING OR ORAL ARGUMENT**

Century Indemnity Company ("CIC") has requested an evidentiary hearing on its claim under Treaty 6. The Liquidator objects to an evidentiary hearing but agrees that oral argument may be of assistance to the Referee.

CIC contends the evidence to be presented at an evidentiary hearing would put the evidence in proper context and allow CIC to expand on the facts already submitted. The Liquidator argues that the issues before the Referee are issues of law and that the witness proposed by CIC has no personal knowledge of the issues on which her testimony is offered.

After reviewing the Section 15 Submissions of both parties, the Referee has instructed the HICIL Clerk to schedule one day of oral argument. The Referee is not persuaded that an evidentiary hearing is appropriate or necessary.

The parties shall confer with the Clerk to find a mutually agreeable date for the oral argument.
