LIQUIDATOR'S PRELIMINARY RESPONSE TO CLAIMANT WILLS MOTION REQUEST

Roger A. Sevigny, Insurance Commissioner for the State of New Hampshire, as
Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home"), provides this preliminary
response to the "Motion Request" filed on behalf of claimant Gregory M. Wills ("Claimant").
Although the Motion Request concerns matters pending in a disputed claim proceeding before
the Referee, it was not served on counsel for the Liquidator. The Motion Request should be
heard in that proceeding, and the Liquidator will provide a substantive response to the Motion
Request in the disputed claim proceeding.

- 1. Counsel for the Liquidator learned of the Motion Request on November 8, 2012, when it was posted to the Liquidation Clerk's website, www.hicilclerk.org. The Motion Request was not served on counsel. (The Motion Request states only that a copy was mailed to the liquidation's Manchester, New Hampshire office. Perhaps due to administrative disruption due to Hurricane Sandy, the liquidation staff handling the Claimant's claim and counsel did not learn of that copy until November 9, 2012.)
- 2. The Motion Request concerns the proof of claim (No. CLMN713953-01) at issue in a disputed claim proceeding before the Referee, Disputed Claim Proceeding No. 2012-HICIL-54, as well as a related proof of claim that was filed by Claimant in connection with that

proceeding (No. CLMN714296). The Motion Request notes the disputed claim proceeding at page 2, paragraphs 6 and 7.

- 3. As the Motion Request concerns matters in 2012-HICIL-54, it is properly addressed in the first instance in that disputed claim proceeding.
- 4. The Liquidator has not yet had time to consider the Motion Request since his counsel and pertinent staff only learned of it on November 8, 2012. The Liquidator will file a substantive response to the Motion Request in Disputed Claim Proceeding 2012-HICIL-54 on or before November 19, 2012.
