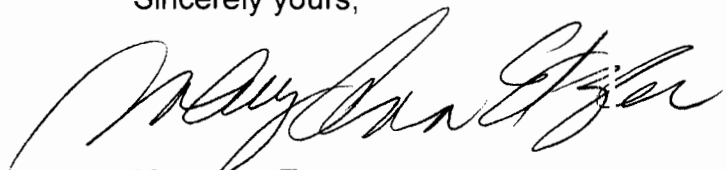

**VIAD'S NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH RESTATED AND REVISED
ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES REGARDING CLAIMS FILED WITH
THE HOME INSURANCE COMPANY IN LIQUIDATION
REGARDING MANDATORY DISCLOSURES**

VIAD CORP, by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files its Notice of Compliance with Rule Number 14 of the *Restated and Revised Order Establishing Procedure Regarding Claims Filed With the Home Insurance Company in Liquidation*, by providing the Liquidator and liquidation Clerk with this written submission on June 11, 2008, stating that:

Amount Due

1. \$: 4,683,299: is the total claim amount that Viad asserts is due for the San Diego, California, site. These costs are directly related to the insured's investigation of the site and claim, preparation of a Contamination Status Report(s) and/or a Contamination Assessment Report(s), developing remediation options, preparing a Corrective Action Plan(s), and implementing remediation measures. Because there was ongoing remediation at this one city block site when Viad's proof of claim was filed, and because at least one third party claim has already been settled, there is a significant risk of exposure for third party or other claims.

Method of Calculating the Amount Due

2. The method of calculation of the amounts owed by the Home Insurance in Liquidation is as follows:

a. \$ 3,327,963.00: Actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in the investigation, assessment, and remediation of the subject property, including but not limited to: costs of compliance with regulatory authority, common consultant(s), consulting evaluations, waste and product disposal, field activities, planning and site preparation, permitting water level measurements, pilot testing, soil and gas surveys, various consultants' costs and administrative charges, project management, cost proposals and bid preparations, equipment purchases, fate and transportation analysis, geophysical surveys, soil and water sampling, systems installation, tank removal, etc., and periodic reporting as required.

b. \$ 1,355,336.00: Interest on sums expended between 1989 and 2004 when Viad's proof of claim was submitted.

Supporting Documentation

3. In 2004, when Viad submitted its proof of claim to the Liquidator, Viad submitted approximately seven (7) boxes of documentation in support of its proof of claim for the San Diego, California, claim. Viad directs the Liquidator to those documents and relies upon these documents as support for its claim on the San Diego, California, matter. Viad submits with this Notice of Compliance a CD disk containing duplicate copies of some of the documents previously submitted, that to Viad's present knowledge, directly support Viad's claim. The attached Exhibit A is an itemized list of

the documents contained on the CD and includes copies of invoices, copies of canceled checks, abatement orders and amendments thereto, various agreements between Transportation Leasing Company (Viad's predecessor in interest) and others.

Additional Documents and/or Evidentiary Material

4. The additional documents or other evidentiary material that Viad presently contends support the amount claimed due are included in the index of documents attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the documents are attached in electronic format on the CD filed with this Notice of Compliance. Those documents include but are not limited to interest and related calculations and detailed work descriptions related to various invoices.


5. This submission and the documents attached hereto is based only upon such information and documents, which are presently available to and specifically known to Viad and it discloses only those claims presently available to Viad. It is anticipated that further discovery, independent investigation, legal research and analysis may supply additional facts and legal contentions, all of which may lead to additions to, changes in, and/or variations in the documents presently produced.

Further, the attached documents are provided without prejudice to Viad's right to produce evidence of any subsequently discovered facts. Viad expressly reserves and preserves the right to produce evidence of any subsequently discovered facts and to amend, supplement, or revise its disclosures as additional facts are ascertained. The documents contained herein are made in a good faith effort to supply as much factual information in a summary format and as is presently known, but shall not prejudice Viad in relation to further discovery.

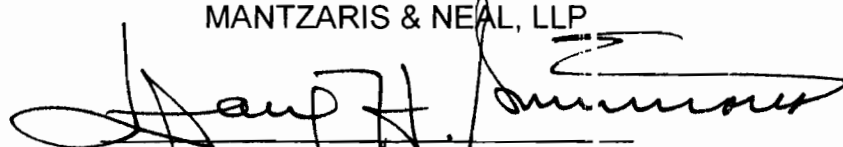
