Dear Sir/Madam:

I am filing an Objection to the Notice of Determination regarding my case.

When I settled my Worker's Comp case years ago, I settled for approximately \$3,000.00. I was not as interested in the monies that I could receive as in receiving the Lifetime Medical that was awarded to me. It was a concern to me that my injuries that had changed my life would continue and might even get worse.

Over the years I have continued to be in pain, sometimes mildly and others quite severe. I think a nerve is involved as when the pain starts, sometimes from sitting on something not padded enough, the pain radiates up from my back into my neck and head causing pain so great that I can hardly stand it.

I had reopened my case to obtain treatment, as my problems had gotten worse. Home Insurance said I could only go to their treatment centers. I found the centers to very poor; some Employees did not care or gave treatments not performed properly. It was no wonder that I was not showing improvement.

Upper back massages that I paid for over the years helped me more than the treatment centers that Home Insurance sent me to. Also the most help I received that lasted the longest was a combination treatment that I received from a doctor in Brea who massaged, performed ultrasound and treated me with a Medex machine.
