## LIQUIDATOR'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 56, the plaintiff, Roger A. Sevigny, in his official capacity as Insurance Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire, as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of The Home Insurance Company ("Home"), moves for summary judgment against the defendants the United States of America and Eric H. Holder, Jr., in his official capacity as Attorney General of the United States ("Attorney General" and, collectively, "United States" or "defendants").

As reasons therefor, the Liquidator relies on the Liquidator's Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment and the Affidavit of Peter A. Bengelsdorf, Special Deputy Liquidator, in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment submitted herewith.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator requests that the Court enter a judgment declaring that:

1. For a "claim" to support personal liability under the Federal Priority Act, a federal official must have determined that funds are owed to the United States by Home based upon

evaluation of specific factual circumstances and advised the Liquidator of that determination before the Liquidator makes a distribution.

- 2. The unknown, possible, or potential claims asserted by the United States in the protective proof of claim and the EPA list are not "claims" that can form the basis for imposing personal liability on the Liquidator under the Federal Priority Act;
- 3. The Liquidator may make the 15% interim distribution to claimants with allowed Class II claims without incurring personal liability to the United States.
